- All 7 principles will be taught hands on; i.e. fires will actually be built, highlines will be put up, tents will be used and cat holes will be dug.

**This is NOT a packing clinic or a horsemanship class.**

### Class objective:

Gain knowledge, understanding, appreciation and practical application of the **7 Leave No Trace Principles**.

This class will provide information on how we as individuals can make a difference protecting our natural resources and keeping equestrians on public land.

#### LNT

- Ideas are not hard and fast rules.
- Is a guide to minimum impact camping and stock use techniques.

*There are many judgements we must each make and LNT helps us do this.*

**LEAVE NO TRACE (LNT)** – A universal program for all recreational endeavors to help protect our natural resources as we enjoy visiting our favorite recreational spots. Practicing LNT principles makes a difference in our acceptance on public lands.

Back Country Horsemen adopted LNT as a major element in keeping public lands open to equestrians.

Recent studies confirm that 90% of equestrians never ride in the back country. Our class offerings also reflect the education needs of front country riders.
