Ken Wilcox Horse Camp at Haney Meadows is located near the summit of Blewitt Pass about 8 miles East of Highway 97. The camp is at about 5500' has a long-storied past with BCHW. A fire in 2012 damaged much of the camp area and surrounding trail system. BCHW volunteers helped restore the camp area, made improvements, and cleared trails every year. Recent years major wind events have brought much of the dead standing timber down combined with new growth overtaking the trails, most of the trail system is clogged. We will continue our volunteer efforts again this year and could use lots of help. The goal here is to keep the Ken Wilcox Horse Camp and the surrounding trail system open to all stock users and the public for their enjoyment.

Be prepared to cook for yourself sorry no food provided Camping sites with overflow area. Hi-line or tie to trailer, stock water available no potable water. Sawyers need to provide their own PPE & equipment. Tools and equipment to cut over grown brush will be very helpful. Work in camp will include Hi-Line installation and cleanup. Great trail riding with easy to moderate trails. Green Trail Map #210 would be a good map of the area Green Trail (#211s) if attainable is even better.
